1 POLICY

The Selkirk College Board of Governors offers \$1,500 tuition awards to students proceeding directly from Grade 12 to a full-time *post secondary* program of studies at Selkirk College.

A total of forty (40) awards will be made available annually where qualified applicants exist. A minimum of one award will be offered to each accredited high school in the College region. Where high schools do not have qualified applicants the award will be offered to the next ranked eligible applicant from those that have applied and are eligible.

2 ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

1. The Selkirk College Board of Governors Secondary Graduates Award is open to all High School graduates within the Selkirk College region.
2. Recipients may seek admission to any full-time academic, career/technical or vocational program offered at any Selkirk College campus or centre. Efforts will be made to distribute scholarships amongst all programs. However, enrollment management strategies may result in certain programs having more entrance scholarships than others.
3. Recipients shall receive their award upon completion of registration requirements.

Selection Process:

1. All students must complete the Entrance Scholarship application by the application deadline date.
2. The selected recipients must have a minimum of 75% average in each of Grades 11 and 12 and will not be receiving any other scholarships from Selkirk College of greater or equal value.
