TITLE STUDENT APPEALS TO THE BOARD

APPROVAL DATE June 27, 2023

NEXT REVIEW June 15, 2026

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to allow students to appeal to the Board of Governors a suspension or expulsion from the college for reasons other than academic standing (Sections 19(1)I, 24(2)e, 37(3), and 37(4) of the College and Institute Act).

Policy

The grounds for student appeal to the Board are:

- a. A flaw in due process or procedures in the determination to suspend or expel the student.
- b. New evidence, not available at the time of the President's decision to suspend or expel the student that may have affected the decision.

The decision to suspend or expel a student will not be changed until the final outcome of the Board Hearing Process is known.

2. APPLIED TO

Selkirk College students who have been suspended or expelled for reasons other than academic standing.

3. LIMITATIONS

The student must file a written notice of appeal to the Board of Governors within twenty (20) working days of the President's decision. Student appeals will be considered strictly on a case-by-case basis.
